- 4.) Membership Drive: Teresa reported on sending membership forms to 120 businesses. She gave forms to Todd to be put at admission gate for volleyball and football games, also for coaches to distribute.

- 2.) High School A.D: Todd reported on the August 19 Fall Sports Team Scrimmages/Parents' Meeting. Volleyball and cross country scrimmage/run will start @ 5:00; football scrimmage will start @ 7:00. An all-sports parent meeting will be in gymnasium @ 6:00. Booster Club membership will be highlighted for parents, and coaches will explain their upcoming sports and expectations.
