

BEARCAT BOOSTER CLUB (February 8, 2017 @ NB Jr.-Sr.High School)

Vice-president John Heeren called the meeting to order @ 5:32 p.m.

Secretary's Report: Motion was made, seconded, and carried (m/s/c) to accept the January 11, 2017 Minutes.

Treasurer's Report: Susan handed out the accompanying sheet and reported on the monies taken in and paid out. Motion was m/s/c to accept the following: General Account--- \$11,616.88 Concessions Account--- \$21,600.70

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- 1.) Membership: Teresa reported that total membership amount is \$16,280. 47 businesses (12 of which are parents of student-athletes) and 44 family/individual (29 of those parents) belong.
- 2.) Secretary to Booster Club: Discussion was held on finding any interested person to nominate for the Club's secretary position, starting June, 2017. Teresa explained that she has typed up instructions for what to do each month and that she would be available to help out the new secretary next school year.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1.) Jr. High A.D. No report given.
- 2.) High School A.D: Todd reported that Coaches vs. Cancer Night raised \$2100, an increase from last year's total of \$1200. Retro Night (Greene and Allison-Bristow teams) has been tabled; no uniforms have been ordered after rethinking and deciding to put those efforts, money toward Coaches vs. Cancer Night or toward honoring past North Butler teams. Todd will look into having Senior Picture Banners displayed at each sport; Voss Studios would work with school. Todd also reported a possibility of 4 wrestlers who qualified for this Saturday's Districts moving on to State Tourney. He will tell Susan how many wrestlers, coaches, cheerleaders to give \$35 to each, according to By-Laws. The Winter Sports Awards will be on Tuesday, March 14, at 7:00 at NB Elementary Auditorium. After discussion on receiving complaints on the length of the night, motion was m/s/c to not serve a meal at the Winter Awards, so that more time is emphasized for the student-athletes, the coaches, the season, and the speaker. Bryan reported on ordering 40 new volleyball uniforms for JJV, JV and varsity. Motion was m/s/c to spend up to \$3200 for those uniforms. Bryan also requested \$110 for the Jr. High AAU volleyball that qualified for State AAU Tournament in March. Booster Club gave the team their entry fee, according to By-Laws. Ross asked for up to \$122 needed for Track items. Motion was m/s/c to pay that amount.
- 3.) Bearcat Apparel: Carrie reported that she will be starting a spring order online. Discussion was held to have more available in youth sizes and to have it better advertised.
