

BEARCAT BOOSTER CLUB (November 9, 2016 @ NB Jr.Sr. High School)

PRESENT: Gail Arjes, Kevin Clipperton, Bryan Tabbert, Susan Stirling, Jeff Stirling, Todd Thompson, Cory Lubben, and Teresa Feldman

President Cory Lubben called the meeting to order @ 5:32 p.m.

Secretary's Report: Motion was made, seconded, & carried (m/s/c) to accept the September 14, 2016 Minutes. (The October 2016 meeting was cancelled because of number of officers unable to attend.)

Treasurer's Report: Susan hand out the accompanying sheet and reported on the monies taken in and paid out. Motion was m/s/c to accept the following: General Account Balance = \$13,423.49 and Concession Acct Balance = \$22,852.56

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- 1.) Booster Club Flood Relief Donation: Susan reported that the \$1200 made in the Homecoming football concessions will be presented to four organizations in the NB community on Tuesday, November 29 before the girls varsity game. The 4 organizations—Allison Fire Dept., Bristow Fire Dept., Greene Fire Dept. & Greene Ambulance Dept.—will also be receiving donation from the NB Community Schools from the gate admissions to that Homecoming game. It was decided to combine our check with school's check; but to state during the presentation that the Booster Club donated the concession amounts from that evening.
- 2.) Articles of Incorporation: Cory reported that Atty Libby Vickers will be completing the paperwork, consisting of retyping/certifying club's ByLaws and putting in writing how Booster Club funds will be dispersed in the event that a new school district would ever form. It was voted to have all funds go to the new school district's Booster Club.
- 3.) Fall Can Drive: Susan reported that we made \$777.00
- 4.) Fall Sports Banquet, Tuesday, November 15: Teresa explained that groceries had been ordered; she will pick up and take to elementary multi-purpose room by 5:30, with serving starting @ 6:00 p.m. til 6:45 p.m. Kim Marshall is donating her time to make the maidrites and cookies. Teresa asked for volunteers to be @ elementary by 5:30 that evening to serve.
- 5.) Membership Drive: Teresa reported that we made \$15,980 in memberships, with 47 businesses (12 of those parents of Jr. Sr. High athletes) and 42 family/individuals (28 of those parents of Jr. Sr. High athletes) Teresa ordered plaques and placards for the business memberships of \$150+, wrote thank-you's and organized in groups for student-athletes to deliver as a way to show appreciation for all that the businesses do. Todd helped out in dispersing the items.
- 6.) Fall Concessions: Discussion was held on positive results and on ideas to make even better.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1.) Jr. High A.D: Kevin requested volleyball uniforms. Motion was m/s/c to pay up to \$750 for 30 uniforms. Jeff also requested need for junior high softball pants. Motion was m/s/c to pay up to \$1000 for them.
- 2.) High School A.D: Todd and Kevin showed the new home girls BB uniforms. Todd and Jeff requested money to buy softball-baseball field drag/brush/blade. Motion was m/s/c to pay up to \$4500 for this. Discussion was held about new cemented shed at baseball/softball fields and about possibility of re-tinning the concession stand there. Todd discussed the positive feedback for the 2 speakers (K. Martin-Malley and Mark Bigler) who spoke to the Jr.Sr High School athletes.
- 3.) Scrap Bins: Cory reported that they are really being used and all money goes to Booster Club.
- 4.) By-Laws: Discussion was held and then motion was m/s/c to increase the amount given to high school team camps to "up to \$500" instead of the original amount in 2004 of \$200.
- 5.) Other: Gail, Kevin, and Teresa asked and thanked the club for the \$100 AfterProm donation as stated in the ByLaws. Also, Teresa reminded all that she will be ending her 9 year role as secretary in May. Next meeting will be on Wednesday, January 11, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. at the NB Elementary.
