

BEARCAT BOOSTER CLUB MINUTES (September 9, 2015 @ NB Elementary)

President Cory Lubben called meeting to order @ 5:34 p.m.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Motion was made, seconded, and carried (m/s/c) to accept the August 12, 2015 Minutes.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Susan handed out the accompanying sheet and reported on monies taken in & paid out. Motion was m/s/c to accept the following: Concession Account = \$12,922.45 General Acct.= \$19,003.24

Teresa has sent Bearcat Thank-you's to Jack Cooper and Cooper Motors and to Lincoln Savings Bank for their generous sponsorship of the Dodge Fundraiser, the donation of meal funds, and the concession stand work. Discussion was held on how busy tent was without a Dodge representative to check over forms and how convenient it would be to have driving forms at the tent by the cars. A big "thank-you" to all the members who volunteered to work. Also, the Booster Club served 16 football player meals and 17 volleyball/crosscountry meals.
